1. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidder to indicate bid number and name of bidding entity in the transaction details field at the time of on-line transfer. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer along with bid.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1) Pre-qualification criteria:

1. The bidder should have experience of having successfully **completed** similar works during last 7 years ending on **31/03/2021** as at (a) or (b) or (c) below:

a) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount of Rs.15.94 Lakh or

b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount of Rs 9.96 Lakh each or

c) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount of Rs 7.97 Lakheach.

2. The bidder must have transport facility like Tractor trolley registered on their name so as to be eligible for this contract. Offer of bidders have to submit documentary evidence (i.e. Registration Certificate) and who do not own any relevant transport facility, to be summarily rejected.

(“Similar work” means supplying of manpower with transport facility like tractor trolley etc. in any work contract.)

3. The average annual financial turnover during the last three (03) years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, i.e., 2018-2019, 2019-2020 & 2020-2021 should be at least Rs 5.97 Lakh.

Documentary evidence in the form of works order copies along with **Completion Certificate** specifying the work and amount of contract should be uploaded. Bidders have to upload documentary proof of PAN, GST registration no., EPF A/c No., ITR/ Annual report containing Balance Sheet and Statement of Profit & Loss Account and Registration Certificate of the relevant transport facility.

2) **Scope of work**

Sub: Cleaning and Removal of lime spillage, removal of Classifier / slaker rejects in Lime Plant in chemical B section of Jaduguda Mill

1. **Removal of spillages in lime plant :-**

The contractor will engage persons to clean spillages generated around lime distributor belt (on the top of the silos/bin), Burnt Lime conveyor belt area (feed to slaker in reagent plant), Burnt lime Bucket elevator hopper and pit and carbide sludge pit etc on daily basis and disposal of the same through lime conveyor belt / carbide sludge pit or as advised by Engineer In-charge.

2. **Removal of classifier and slaker rejects:-**

The contractor will engage persons for removal and loading of classifier / slaker rejects on daily basis or as advised by Engineer In-charge in to tractor-trailer/trolley arranged by the party at their own cost and unloading to limestone plant on daily basis or as advised by Engineer In-Charge after weighment.

3. **Quantity to be handled and Rate & Profit:-**

The quantities as mentioned above are only indicative and may somewhat vary in actual situations.

The rate for both the job should be quoted reasonably. The contractor's profit depends on the "Grand Total" value in Section - IX and not on the individual job i.e. Sl. No. 1 & 2.

4. **Required Manpower :-**

A) The contractor will engage minimum 3 (three) nos. manpower required for

job in Sl.No 01 as detailed above without fail on all working days, except Sunday and Holidays.

- B) For Job in Sl.No 02, the party will have to engage tractor with trailer/trolley and minimum 04 nos. of manpower (unskilled) & 1 driver (Skilled) manpower. The contractor will have to arrange tractor trolley for classifier & slaker reject removal. The company will not provide any means of transportation for classifier reject removal at any cost. Offer of bidders have to submit documentary evidence (i.e. Registration certificate) and who do not own any relevant transport facility, to be summarily rejected. The estimate is prepared 37 considering transportation cost components directly or indirectly along with manpower involved in this job.

Note: (Common for above jobs)

- i) Contractor will have to arrange and provide transport facility like tractor trolley or relevant to plant condition, its fuel, etc. purely at their own cost. The company will not provide any means of Transportation, fuel etc. for cleaning and removal of slurry/spillage/scaling in any of the job mentioned above.
- ii) The estimate is prepared considering transportation cost components (directly and indirectly) along with manpower involved in this job.

Disclaimer

6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.

8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
