The contractor shall be told to supply any particular vehicle as per schedule of quantity one day in or. In case of non-availability of the vehicle due to any reasons, the hire charges **would be deduct at double the daily hire charges of that particular vehicle for one hour** from the monthly R. Bills (Running Account Bills).

Example: Suppose Dumper hire charges for one hour is Rs.1000/-. In case contractor fai to supply on any requested day, double penalty of Rs.2000/- shall be levied/hour. And thi may continue till the of non-availability of the vehicle.
