ADMISSION CIRCULAR

Applications are invited for admissions under RTE Act to class I and other Non-DAE categories to classes I & VI in AECS-1 & 2 Jaduguda for the session 2017-2018 against the seats available as given below:

General information:

1. Admissions under RTE Act will be granted **only** to class I.
2. There will be **no admission test** for the students seeking admissions to classes I & VI.
3. Admissions under RTE Act and other Non- DAE categories at Jaduguda will be regulated centrally at the co-ordinating school, AECS-1, Jaduguda. **Admission Forms for both the schools i.e. AECS-1 and AECS-2, Jaduguda will be issued at AECS-1, Jaduguda.**
4. The grant of Non-DAE admissions is subject to availability of seats in respective classes after completion of DAE and RTE admissions in the respective AEC Schools.

Children admitted under Non-DAE category at Jaduguda will be subject to admission in either of the schools (AECS-1 or AECS-2) as per the availability of the seats and may be subject to change at any time as per the discretion of the Chairman, LMC.

Parents are advised not to wholly depend on AEES for admissions.

Mere issue and acceptance of Admission Forms will not guarantee Non-DAE admission to the applicants.

5. AGE

The **eligible minimum and maximum age as on 31.03.17** for admission in classes I & VI are as follows:

6. ADMISSION FORM

Admission forms for Non-DAE wards can be obtained from the AECS-1, Jaduguda school office by paying a fee of **Rs.200/-** .

OR

Application Form can be downloaded from AEES website : **www.aees.gov.in**. The duly filled in form along with a fee of Rs.200/- should be submitted to AECS-1,Jaduguda school office.

However, this fee will not be charged from the applicants under RTE Act.

Separate admissions forms need to be submitted if the admission is sought under more than one category, i.e RTE and other Non-DAE categories. (ND-1 to ND-4).

I. FOR ADMISSIONS UNDER RTE ACT

A. Method of admission under RTE ACT

No admission test will be conducted for the students seeking admission to class I. If the number of applicants seeking admission to Class I under the provisions of RTE Act is more than the seats available, selection will be made by a draw of lots in presence of parents.

B. Eligibility for grant of admission to Class I under the provisions of RTE Act.

Children residing in the neighborhood area who belong to Disadvantaged Group and /or Weaker Section as per Jharkhand Govt. notification are eligible to seek admission under the provisions of RTE Act, 2009.

DEFINITION OF DISADVANTAGED GROUP /WEAKER SECTION / NEIGHBOURHOOD

a) Definition of disadvantaged group

1. “Child belonging to disadvantaged group” means a child belonging to the Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe, the socially and educationally backward class or such other group having disadvantage owing to social, cultural, economic, geographical, linguistic, gender or such other factor as may be specified by the Jharkhand government, by notification.
2. “Child with special needs and suffering from disability” will be determined as per the provision mentioned in RTE Act 2009 or as defined by the Govt. of Jharkhand.

b) Definition of weaker section

“Child belonging to weaker section” means a child belonging to such a parent or guardian (declared by a Court or a Statute) whose annual income is lower than the minimum limit specified by the Jharkhand government, by notification.

The income limit regarding economically weaker sections will be applicable as notified by the Govt. of Jharkhand.

c) Definition of neighbourhood

The residence of the child should be within 1 km radius from AEC School-1 Jaduguda. If sufficient number of children are not available within 1 km radius from the school, children residing within an extended limit i.e. within 3 km radius from the school will be considered for admission. If the seats are still vacant, children residing within 6 km radius from the school will be considered.

d) Proof of residence

Proof of residence shall have to be produced by all the applicants.

Documents required to be submitted with filled in application forms for admission under RTE Act

Attested copies of the following documents are required to be submitted along with filled in application form and originals at the time of admission in the respective school office where admission is granted under the provisions of RTE Act.

1. For Class-I, certificate of proof of age in the form of original birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council / Municipality / Municipality Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat endorsed under the seal and signature of the Revenue / Panchayat officer of the concerned area. **Admission will not be granted on the basis of an affidavit in lieu of a birth certificate.**
2. A certificate that the child belongs to the Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / EWS / OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ BPL / Differently-abled, wherever applicable, issued by the competent authority of concerned State Government/ Union Government. The certificate in respect of either of the parents may be accepted initially, for the purpose of admission, if this certificate is not available for the child. However, the certificate in respect of the child has to be submitted within a period of 3 months from the date of admission.
3. A certificate from the civil surgeon / rehabilitation centre or any other competent authority defined by the Government of India certifying the child to be handicapped, wherever applicable.
4. Attested copies of Aadhar card/ Ration card of parents along with the name of the child.
5. Income certificate issued by the employer concerned / Revenue authorities in respect of parents of all categories of applicants.
6. Proof of residence (essential) and distance from the school will be taken from Caste Certificate / Aadhar Card / Voter ID / MNREGA Card / Ration Card / Driving License / Electricity Bill containing address of the child / parent.
7. Any other document(s) as advised / required by the Principal.

II. FOR ADMISSIONS UNDER OTHER NON-DAE CATEGORIES

A) Method of admission

No admission test will be conducted for the students seeking admission to class I & VI. Admission will be granted subject to approval from the competent authority in AEES.

B) AVAILABILITY OF SEATS

Non-DAE admissions under categories from ND – 1 to ND - 4 will be considered subject to the availability of seats. **The vacancies are tentative and may change. Parents are advised not to wholly depend on AEES for admissions. Mere issue and acceptance of admission forms will not guarantee Non-DAE admission to the applicants.**

C) CATEGORIES OF NON-DAE WARDS & ELIGIBILITY FOR SEEKING ADMISSIONS AGAINST VACANT SEATS

ND-1 For the Project Affected People (PAP) category “ND-1”, admission will be granted in preference to the order of generation. Submission of Khursinama issued by the SDO and land certificate issued by competent authority in State Govt./ UCIL are mandatory.

ND-2 (a) Wards of Central/ State Govt./ PSU Employees engaged in DAE/UCIL activities, Banks/Post offices, etc. must produce service certificate along with other mandatory certificates.

ND-2 (b) : Major Contractors and their regular employees :

- 1) A contractor should be in running contract.
- 2) Recommending authority should be the Unit/ Dept. Head/ Sectional Head of respective units of UCIL.

ND-2(c) Defence : Wards of defence/paramilitary personnel or wards of their widows residing within 5 km radius from AECS-1, Jaduguda. Relevant proofs should be attached.

ND-3 Grandchildren of DAE employees

Grandchildren of DAE employees are divided into two categories as given below:

- (a) Grandchildren of DAE employees who are applying for the first time.
- (b) Grandchildren of DAE employees who are applying for the second time.

Preference will be given in the order of serving/retired or expired/VRS DAE employees.

However, grandchildren of AEES employees will have preference.

Eligibility of the candidates applying under grandchild category (i.e. ND-3 a & b)

Applications must be certified by the personnel section of the concerned unit in respect of service details etc. of the Grandfather.

ND-4 Wards of people residing around DAE establishment within a radius of 5 km.

D) DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR ADMISSION

- i. For Class-I, certificate of proof of age in the form of original birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council / Municipality / Municipality Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat endorsed under the seal and signature of the Revenue / Panchayat officer of the concerned area. **Admission will not be granted on the basis of an affidavit in lieu of a birth certificate.**
- ii. **For other classes:** A valid and original Transfer Certificate (TC) from the school last attended as per the guidelines issued by CBSE.
- iii. **Other documents required under categories ND - 1 to ND - 4**

1. Parents of wards who belong to ND-1 Category should submit relevant documents thereof from the concerned authorities i.e. Revenue Department / DAE Unit.
2. Parents of the wards of Central/State Govt/PSU employees engaged in DAE activities and/or working for the DAE applying under ND-2 category have to furnish a copy of their posting order along with the latest salary slip. The duly filled in application form has to be submitted to the school authorities after obtaining the counter signature of the administrative authorities of local DAE unit.
3. Parents of wards of employees of the major contractors working for DAE units applying under ND-2 category have to furnish a copy of their posting order along with the latest salary slip. The duly filled in application form has to be submitted to the school authorities after obtaining the counter signature of the administrative authorities of local DAE unit.
4. Wards of defence / paramilitary personnel or wards of their widows applying under ND-2 category should submit the documentary proof stating that their parents are/were defence / paramilitary personnel. They should also submit the proof of residence.
5. Parents of wards who belong to ND-4 category should submit the proof of residence.
6. Non-DAE parents of all the aforesaid categories have to furnish latest salary certificate issued by employers concerned in original or latest income certificate in original issued by the Revenue / DAE authorities along with the application.
7. Immediately after obtaining the admission, parents are requested to collect back the original birth certificate while submitting an attested copy of birth certificate in the school for record.
8. Original T. C. is to be submitted at the time of taking the admission and this will not be returned if a student seeks to leave the school.
9. Photocopy of the last Report Card of the class for which annual examination was given.
10. Photocopy of residence allotment letter issued by the concerned DAE Unit allotment section, wherever applicable.
11. Attested photocopy of the caste certificate (issued by competent authority i.e SDO/Tahsildar) **in the name of the student** has to be furnished in order to avail fee concession. Caste certificate of the parent shall not be considered.
12. Fee concession for girls will be granted only upon furnishing the Affidavit for child's status.
